FALL 2011 COURSES

BEGINNER I

Sundays 3:00 pm to 4:30 pm (Sept. 11 to Dec. 11)
180 Woodbury St. #327, Manchester, NH*

A course for those who have little or no knowledge of Irish. Emphasis is on basic conversation, pronunciation, and sentence structure. The course includes learning of songs in Irish and may include supplemental readings and games. *Instructor: Domi O'Brien.*

INTERMEDIATE I

Sundays 1:30 pm to 3:00 pm (Sept. 11 to Dec. 11)
180 Woodbury St. #327, Manchester, NH*

A course for those with a sound foundation of the basics of Irish, and who are comfortable with short conversations in Irish and the use of reference books. This course often includes the use of supplemental materials and the learning of songs or poems in Irish.

Instructor: Domi O'Brien.

ADVANCED I

Sundays 3:15 pm to 4:45 pm (Sept. 11 to Dec. 11)
4 Elm Street (3rd floor), Manchester, NH**

A course for those who have studied Irish for two or more years, and who are comfortable with basic conversation and grammar, and with an adequate ability to express their thoughts through Irish. Advanced I will build upon previous knowledge by testing comprehension and pronunciation skills, expanding vocabulary and fluency, and building an overall confidence in one's command of the language. *Instructor: Peter Vatne.*

IRISH TRANSLATION GROUP

Sundays 4:45 pm to 6:15 pm (Sept. 11 to Dec. 11)
4 Elm Street (3rd floor), Manchester, NH**

A weekly gathering of intermediate/advanced Irish language learners who will read/translate books in Irish to improve their vocabulary, grammar and reading skills. Any materials used for this course will be decided upon by the students and coordinator at the first meeting. *Group Coordinator: Peter Vatne.*
