He has led a Learning Irish study group (2013-2015), and has coordinated a Ciorcal Comhra (Conversation Circle) since 2015.

Peter Vatne began his Irish language studies in Nashua, NH in 1994. He has led many study groups in recent years and began teaching full-length courses for the first time in 2009.
