AUTUMN 2019 COURSES

Irish/Gaeilge 1: *Irish/Gaeilge 1* is an introductory course that covers the basics of Irish — pronunciation, grammar and conversation. This course often includes the learning of songs, poems and colorful idiom. **REQUIRED TEXTBOOK:** *Progress in Irish* by Máiréad Ní Ghráda (These will be available for purchase at the first class) **SUGGESTED BOOKS:** see our recommendations below

Irish/Gaeilge 4: *Irish/Gaeilge 4* is a continuation course for those who have had at least two years' prior study of Irish. *Irish/Gaeilge 4* will further refine basic conversation skills and understanding of written Irish. **REQUIRED TEXTBOOK:** *Progress in Irish* by Máiréad Ní Ghráda

Irish/Gaeilge 6: For the committed student of Irish, *Irish/Gaeilge 6* will help round out the student's knowledge of Irish using both textbooks and supplemental material. **REQUIRED COURSE MATERIAL:** *Living Language Irish: Complete Edition*

Irish/Gaeilge 6 will meet from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.;

The semester consists of 12 weekly classes, held on Thursday evenings beginning **12 September 2019**. Classes will be held in the **Parish Hall** at the **Sts. Constantine & Helen Church, 37 Lake Parkway, Webster, Massachusetts** (entrance to the Parish Hall is to the left of the church)

INSTRUCTOR

Cionaoth Mac Pheadair (Kenneth Peterson), a founding member of the New England branch of Conradh na Gaeilge, began studying Irish in 1982, and has been teaching Irish in various New England locations since 1989, including eleven years in New Hampshire, twenty-two years in Massachusetts and two years in Connecticut. He has been a guest lecturer at Clark University, a consultant on two Irish language software programs, and has tutored Irish language students through the Internet.
